Qualifying Procedures: Each car will be given two (2) qualifying laps with the best lap establishing their qualifying time. CARS OUT OF ORDER FOR PRE-QUALIFYING TECH INSPECTION MAY BE PENALIZED ONE LAP OF QUALIFYING. The top 16 qualifiers will transfer directly into feature event with an invert of roll plus 7 (8-13) and will contest odd/even heats, fully inverted with points awarded. The remainder of cars will be split into one or two qualifying races with a total of four (4) cars transferring into feature to fill positions 17-20. Cars not transferring will run a last chance race(s), with starting positions being straight up from qualifying race finish order with a total of 4 cars transferring into positions 21-24.

Provisional Starting Positions: In order to be eligible for provisional starting position, car must be deemed to make every attempt to transfer by traditional means. Position 25-26 highest in 2018 ARCAMT Points, Position 27 reserved for any Trickle Segment winner and/or Overall Trickle winner not yet in field. Position 28 reserved for any Sunday Oktoberfest Headline Feature Winner not yet in field. When no eligible cars are available for a Provisional prior to Last Chance event, additional transfer(s) will be awarded from Last Chance event to fill field at tail of field. If no eligible cars are available for a Provisional following Last Chance event, fastest non-transferring car from qualifying will fill Provisional at tail of field.

Feature Event: 200 lap feature event with yellow flag laps counting until last ten laps of event. Controlled pit stops will be utilized at this event, no car may lose a lap under caution while pitting, no car will lose positions in regards to other cars that pitted under same caution period. Minimum pit open will be four laps ***NEW: These four laps will NOT count*** under each caution, unless declared a 'Quickie Yellow'. If span of green flag goes 50 laps without caution, a 'Competition Caution' will utilized in next 15 laps.

Crate engine (CRA Legal) with 650 4 bbl Holley allowed 6300 RPM Ford, 6400 RPM Chevy, 2650 lbs. Deduct 50 lbs for GM 604 with original seals and no updates. Wegner 5.3 LS engine with 4412 2 bbl Holley – 500cfm allowed 7,600 RPM, 2675 lbs (Midwest Tour points will not be awarded to any tour regular with 604 or 5.3 package). Weight break for Big 8 approved shock/spring 'conventional' on all corners of 40 lbs. Weight break for KONI Spec Shock/Big 8 spring on all corners of 60 lbs.

Practice: NOTICE there will be no private practice allowed for two weeks prior to this event, teams will be permitted to participate in scheduled 'open practice(s)' at host track during this time, including Saturday September 29 from 11am-3pm, Wednesday October 3, Thursday October 4 and Friday October 5.

Tires: Approved Tire Combination for this event 3035 left and 3045 right, all new tires for race and practice must be purchased at event from approved tire vendor. Tires can be pre-ordered for at track delivery by calling Dave Grueneberg at 608-513-2278. Fuel: NO FUEL AVAILABLE AT TRACK. Sunoco Race Fuel is the Official Race Fuel of ARCAMT. All competitors are 'highly recommended' to purchase a minimum of ten (10) gallons.

Memberships: In order to earn ARCAMT Bonus, Point Fund and Series Contingency Awards, both the driver and owner must be a FULL ARCA Member. If an owner changes drivers and the new driver is a non-member, the new driver needs to become a FULL member in order to be eligible for awards listed above. Both driver and owner must be FULL members to enter at ARCA Member Entry Fee. <https://arcamt.racing/18reg>

Temporary Memberships: All competing drivers are required to be ARCA Members and are allowed to purchase a single event temporary membership for \$50 per event. Temporary membership purchases CANNOT be applied toward the cost of a FULL membership. Temporary Members will become eligible for any local contingency awards for each event they compete in.

Spotters: It is the responsibility of all teams participating in an ARCAMT event to provide a qualified spotter. That spotter must report to the assigned spotters area prior to any on-track activities. All spotters are required to monitor race control 455.3000 via scanner/raceceiver.
